

2019-2020 School of Engineering Incoming Freshman Scholarship Application (For <u>current H.S. Seniors</u>)

PRIORITY DEADLINE: February 1, 2019 (Engineering Scholarships open to Incoming Freshmen only)
GENERAL DEADLINE: June 1, 2019 (Engineering Scholarships open to all students admitted in the School of Engineering at UNM). If you submit an application by February 1st, you do not need to re-apply by June 1st.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Student must be a <u>current</u> H.S. Senior
- 2. Student must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
- 3. For most awards, student must have a minimum 22 in ACT-Math or 510 in SAT-Math (Most recent ACT/SAT Math score will be considered).
- 4. Student must indicate their major as Engineering or Computer Science at the University of New Mexico
- 5. Although you are not required at the time of application for this scholarship, in order to be considered eligible to compete for an UNM-Engineering scholarship, students *must* be admitted into UNM by the time of the scholarship selection. Students already in the UNM system who meet UNM minimum requirements for admissions and who mark Engineering or Computer Science as their major, will automatically be admitted as Incoming Freshmen in the School of Engineering Pre-major program they indicate, and their scholarship applications will be forwarded to the Engineering Scholarship Selection Committee.
